SENIOR PORTRAIT INFORMATION

A portrait is NOT a Smart Phone photo.

To reserve a space in the yearbook, students should sit for the “school photo” even if they plan on replacing that photo. The school “retake” photo is acceptable for this purpose. If a student purposely screws around for the portrait the school provides at the beginning of the school year—intentional funny faces, messy hair, disrespectful poses—they forfeit their right to replace that photo with a professional portrait.

- DEADLINE: December 6, 2017..
- We accept vertical format, COLOR, head and shoulder pictures only.
- NO NEON or “crazy” backgrounds. Blue or Grey is preferred.
- Outdoor shots are accepted, but they must be “professional” and use shallow depth of field.
- Extreme close-ups are not allowed.
- FACE the camera. We will not accept “staring off in the distance photos.”
- Props are not allowed; this includes hats and masks.
- Hands/elbows should not be framing/near the face.
- Distorted/Filtered photos are not allowed. Soft focus is not allowed.
- Neither harsh “whiteout” flash NOR “flash shadows” are allowed.
- Digital images should be at least 300 DPI (the photographer will know what this means).
- If this were to be printed it would be a 2 X 3 inch VERTICAL picture with the head size being about 1¾ inches from chin to top of head.
 - Avoid sending oversized files; if the file is set to print a High Quality 8 X 10, we generally cannot use it because we cannot “shrink” it enough for our purposes.
- No watermarks or photographer logos allowed.
- Snapshots/selfies are discouraged. Pictures are expected to be PORTRAITS and students can have a free, professional portrait taken at registration (or retakes).
- We reserve the right to refuse any photo that does not fit these guidelines, is in violation of school code, or, in our exclusive opinion, *detracts in any manner* from the quality or purpose of the yearbook.
- We reserve the right to use your school photo if you do not submit an acceptable photo.
- VERIFICATION: Photos will be posted for student review before they are sent to print. It is the student’s responsibility to verify that the correct photo and name spelling is used.
- There are no refunds on yearbook purchases for any reason including customer dissatisfaction for misidentification, photo omissions or spelling mistakes and other such “human errors.”
- We will try, but are not required to notify students if we do not accept (or cannot use) a submitted photo.
